Media Center Volunteers

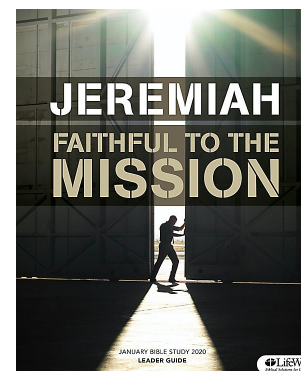
