The Foolishness of the Cross

“For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing,
but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.”

I Corinthians 1:18

The cross of Jesus Christ. It is such a pivotal piece of wood in the timeline of history. This piece of wood divides our centuries into AD and BC. It divides families and friends who believe in Jesus Christ and those that do not believe. From the world’s perspective, the cross is such foolishness. The cross is the scorner’s delight. For those that believe, it is the power of God to save all that call upon the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

The hymnal in our church has a lot to say about what happened that day outside Jerusalem, so very long ago. The hymns acknowledge the blood that was spilt there on Calvary. Hymns like, *There’s Power in the Blood*, *The Blood Will Never Lose Its Power*, and *Jesus Paid It All*. We sing about the cross through songs like, *At the Cross*, *Down at the Cross*, and *The Old Rugged Cross*. It is in the cross we see the Love of God so richly demonstrated. We sing *What Wondrous Love Is This*, *When I Survey the Wondrous Cross*, and *O How He Loves You and Me*.

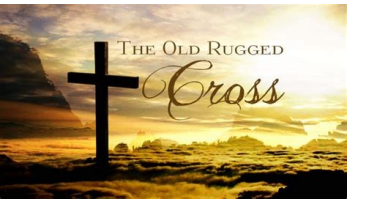
In one of Billy Graham’s sermons, he described the **Dimensions of the Cross: Four Aspects of God’s Love**.

- 1) **Width** – Jesus reached out His arms displaying His love for every single person.
- 2) **Length** – from eternity past to eternity future, God is demonstrating His love.
- 3) **Height** – the cross reaches up to heaven and draws all people to Him that will place their trust in the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 4) **Depth** – the love of God reached down to the worst sinner. No one is beyond the forgiveness and love of God.

February is traditionally known for Valentine’s Day with a great deal of emphasis on love. What greater love did God have for us that He sent His one and Only son, Jesus Christ to redeem sinners. Jesus came to earth for one single purpose – that was to go to the cross! The greatest need of mankind is not wealth, health, safety, or security. It is forgiveness. It is in the cross we find forgiveness and restoration with our Heavenly Father through Jesus Christ. Jesus told His disciple, “*And I, if I am lifted up from the earth (crucified), will draw all peoples to Myself.*” – John 12:32

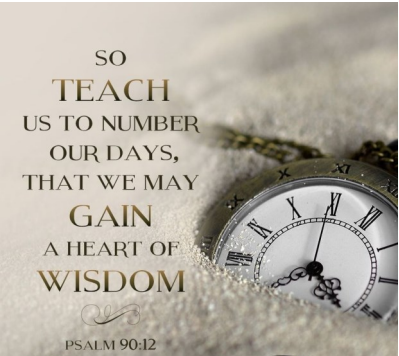
