A Prayer Guide for Holy Week 2023

This week in the life of Jesus has had more attention given to it than any other event in


history. We have seen books written, movies produced, dramas enacted, poems penned, songs sung, and sermons delivered. It seems as if we would be tired of this story by now.




Deacon of the Month LARRY WILLIAMS APRIL 2023
