

National Day of Prayer-May 4, 2023

Every year, Christians across the United States of America have gathered in their communities to pray for our nation. The first Thursday in May our community will gather at Granger Stadium pray for our elected local, state, and national leaders. We pray for our local police, fire and rescue departments.
