Jesus cooked some bread and fish on a fire for His disciples by the Sea of Galilee after His resurrection. He even took the Passover bread, on the night before His crucifixion, and reinstituted the bread as a way for His followers to remember "His body which was broken for us."

Christian churches all across the world gather and remember Jesus' sacrifice and celebrate the Eucharist,

I have sat beside the Garden Tomb in Israel and shared a piece of bread and a cup of juice with fellow believers. It has been my privilege to serve and be served among God's people in two congregations where I have served as their Pastor.

While some churches may observe Communion each week, Spilman celebrates the Lord's Supper the first Sunday of each month. At the center of our worship space sits the Table of Remembrance – "Do This In Remembrance of Me" At the heart of worship is the celebration of the "Bread of Life" that has come so we may have everlasting life. At the heart of worship is the celebration of Christ's complete blood sacrifice for our sin. Jesus said, "I Am the True Vine." His body (bread) and His blood (juice/wine) are so central to our connection to Jesus Christ as our Savior.

Jesus went so far as to say in John 6 that His body and blood provide eternal life. We are to receive Jesus in the same manner in which we take in bread and juice/wine. This difficult teaching caused many people to turn away from Jesus because they could not believe and they deserted Him. As the supposed "disciples" deserted Jesus, Jesus turned and asked, "Do you also want to go away?" Simon Peter answered and said, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We also have come to believe and know You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God."

As we enter into a New Year, may we continue to be found faithful in studying God's word – bread for our soul. May we continue in fellowship with one another as we break bread around the Communion Table. May we be an encouragement to others who are not able to attend physically any more. May we continue to serve one another and our community out of the love Christ has shown us. As we partake of the various breads in the coming year, may we think of the "Bread of Life" – Jesus Christ – who came to give us Everlasting life!
