In the Blink of an Eye

I was traveling to Kinston one morning recently and saw a young man had turned his truck over and it was upside-down in a ditch. I stopped to see if I could help. He was a bit shaken up, had a few cuts on his hand, but otherwise, he seemed to be doing pretty good. He kept asking, "Where is the other truck that pulled out in front of me?" "In the blink of an eye," his life changed.

I have sat in a doctor's office with a family member and heard the news from the doctor that they had cancer. "In the blink of an eye," our lives were changed. I have watched peoples lives literally change in just a brief moment with both good and bad news.

I have been present at the birth of a child and saw how that family embraced this blessing from God. I have been present with someone as they received devastating news of the death of their son in an auto accident. "In the blink of an eye" means that something happened suddenly, quickly, or at the last moment, and that it will be followed by a change of state or condition.

We go through the mundane things of life with very few changes. We wake up, eat breakfast, exercise, travel to work, pay our bills, go to the grocery store, mow the grass, change the oil in our car, vacuum the house, wash the dishes, take a shower, brush our teeth, take our medicine, read a book, and go to bed. But then one day – something happens and interrupts our routine. "In the blink of an eye," something happens which changes everything!


When Jesus Christ came to earth, born unto the virgin Mary, in the village of Bethlehem, everything changed! Into what was the dull monotony of life filled with longing and unfulfillment, came the Messiah to tell us the Good News – Salvation has come! With every person that met Jesus, their lives were changed "in the blink of an eye!" Mary the mother of Jesus, the family at the wedding at Cana, the twelve disciples, and all those whom Jesus healed – their lives were changed. 
In the Blink of an Eye (Continued)
