The Love of God Beckons Us to Come

We have just completed a careful study of the *Book of Revelation* during our Wednesday Bible Study. I have several observations that I would like to share with you today.

This is my third time with a group of people carefully studying this important book. My first time was with a group of deaf people at First Baptist Church, Kinston that wanted an in-depth Bible Study of this book. The second time was while I was at Fremont Missionary Baptist Church. Last year, several people at Spilman asked that we depart from our weekly Lectionary study and study the *Book of Revelation*.

This 66th Book in the Bible promises a blessing for those that <u>read</u>, <u>hear</u>, and <u>keep</u> the words written in this prophetic book. I can say I have been blessed immensely.

The letters written to the seven churches in Asia are just as applicable today as they were when they were first written (chapters 2-3). The vision of the throne room of heaven, with the rainbow encircling it, causes me to look forward to seeing this place for myself. The saints and living creatures singing "Holy, Holy, Holy" leads me to worship the One seated upon the throne (ch. 4).

The unrolling of the scroll of judgement could only be opened by the Lamb of God, the Lion of Judah, the Root of David – Jesus Christ. Worthy is the Lamb that was slain! (chapter 5).

As the various seals are broken, and judgement falls upon the world, death and destruction falls upon a judged world and a judged people. We do see glimpses of people not bowing their knee to Satan. They willingly give up their lives instead of yielding to the oppressive economic, political, and spiritual pressure to conform.

We see glimpses of heavenly worship and praise to God by great multitudes that could not be numbered. (chapter 7) The great war against Satan, the Antichrist, and the false prophet ends with them being banished to the Lake of Fire. Even Death and Hades are banished to the Lake of fire forever. 
God has prepared the New Jerusalem for believers to live eternally with God in His presence, in peace, harmony, and joy. (chapter 21)
