1. Passover	March/April	Redemption/Sacrifice/Death of Messiah	Fulfilled
2. Unleavened Bread	March/April	Sanctification/Burial of Messiah/No decay	Fulfilled
3. Firstfruits	March/April	Represents the Savior as first of the harvest	Fulfilled
4. Pentecost	May/June	Pentecost/Holy Spirit sent by YHWH	Fulfilled
5. Rosh HaShanah	September/October	New Year Messiah returns to Israel ("Rapture")	Future
6. Yom Kippur	September/October	Day of Atonement/Messiah saves Israel	Future
7. Tabernacles	September/October	Wedding Feast/Golden Age/Messiah starts Millennium	Future
